2011 Washington, DC Broomball Invitational HOUSE RULES

- Each game consists of two stop time 18-minute halves.
- The DCBI utilizes the "floating blue line" concept. That is, once an attacking player has crossed the blue line in the offensive zone, the red line now becomes the designated offside line.
- High sticking rules will be in effect. Two minute penalties will be assigned to any player **who plays a ball above their shoulders**, or who hits another player with a stick above their shoulders.
- Icing occurs when any player of a defending team shoots or intentionally deflects the ball from behind their defending zone blue line and across the goal line of the opposing team. Icing is ruled automatically and only if the ball is unplayable by either team and if the goalie is in or headed back to the crease. **Icing is allowed when a team is shorthanded due to penalty.**
- At all times, at least one female player from each team must be on the ice. If a team has less than one woman on the ice they will be assessed a "too many men on the ice" bench minor that can be served by any player on the ice when the whistle blew, as selected by the captain. If a female player is sent to the penalty box, she counts as the one female on the ice.
- Only the designated captain and assistant captains from each team may converse or discuss calls with the referees. All captains and assistant captains should have the applicable "C" or "A" on their jerseys.
- Should a pool play game end in a tie after 2 periods, there will be a 5 minute, 4-on-4 (3 men and 1 woman) with no goalies, stop time, sudden-death overtime period. If neither team scores, the game will end in a tie.
- Should an elimination tournament game end in a tie after 2 periods, there will be a 5 minute, 4-on-4 (3 men and 1 woman) WITH goalies, sudden-death overtime period. Should there still not be a winner following the first overtime, there will be unlimited 5 minute, 4-on-4 (3 men and 1 woman), sudden-death overtime periods WITHOUT GOALIES to determine a winner.
- Each team receives one timeout per game.
- All other USA Broomball rules will be in effect.



2011 Washington, DC Broomball Invitational POOL PLAY & STANDINGS

Standings during pool play will be determined by a point system with 2 points being assigned for every win (regulation or overtime), 1 point being awarded for every tie and 0 points being assigned for every loss. At the end of pool play, the teams will be ranked and placed into the single elimination tournament bracket.

Ties between two teams will be decided in the rankings by:

- (1) Head to head
- (2) Goal differential
- (3) Most goals scored
- (4) Coin flip

Ties between more than two teams will be decided in the rankings by:

- (1) If one team wins all head to head competitions, they win the tie
- (2) Goal differential in the games among the tied teams
- (3) Most goals scored in the games among the tied teams
- (4) Goal differential in all pool play games
- (5) Most goals scored in all pool play games
- (6) Coin flip

2011 Washington, DC Broomball Invitational ABOUT OUR CHARITY

The Southeast White House is located on Pennsylvania Avenue one mile east of the Anacostia River in Southeast Washington, D.C. It is affectionately known in the community as the Little White House due to its distinctive architecture and its location four miles east of the "real" White House.

The Southeast White House is situated in an area that is often referred to as the forgotten quadrant of the city because of the limited number of social services and assistance available to the community.



Demographically, the median income in Southeast Washington, D.C. is \$17,000 per year. 22% of the population live in public housing and 35% qualify for public assistance. 77% of the children live in single-parent families.

The Southeast White House serves as a:

- place for reconciliation for all that divides the city and the city from the rest of the world
- refuge and resource center serving the needs of the Randle Highlands, Hill Crest, Penn Branch, Congress Heights, and Fort Dupont communities in Southeast Washington, D.C.
- base for mentoring and other forms of support to the local youth population (approximately 150 children served)
- gathering place for individuals and groups working with the poor and disenfranchised of the District of Columbia and the Washington Metropolitan Area
- training group for those seeking a greater exposure to the inner-city and related urban issues

Holiday Inn

The Holiday Inn of Gaithersburg has generously donated the use of their shuttle to DCBI participants during tournament games and the official DCBI party.

The shuttle will be making trips between the hotel and rink every hour on the following schedule:

Sunday: 8:45AM—2:30PM

In addition to the scheduled hourly trips between the rink and hotel, players can also make arrangements at the front desk for transportation to and from the official tournament party at Growlers of Gaithersburg.

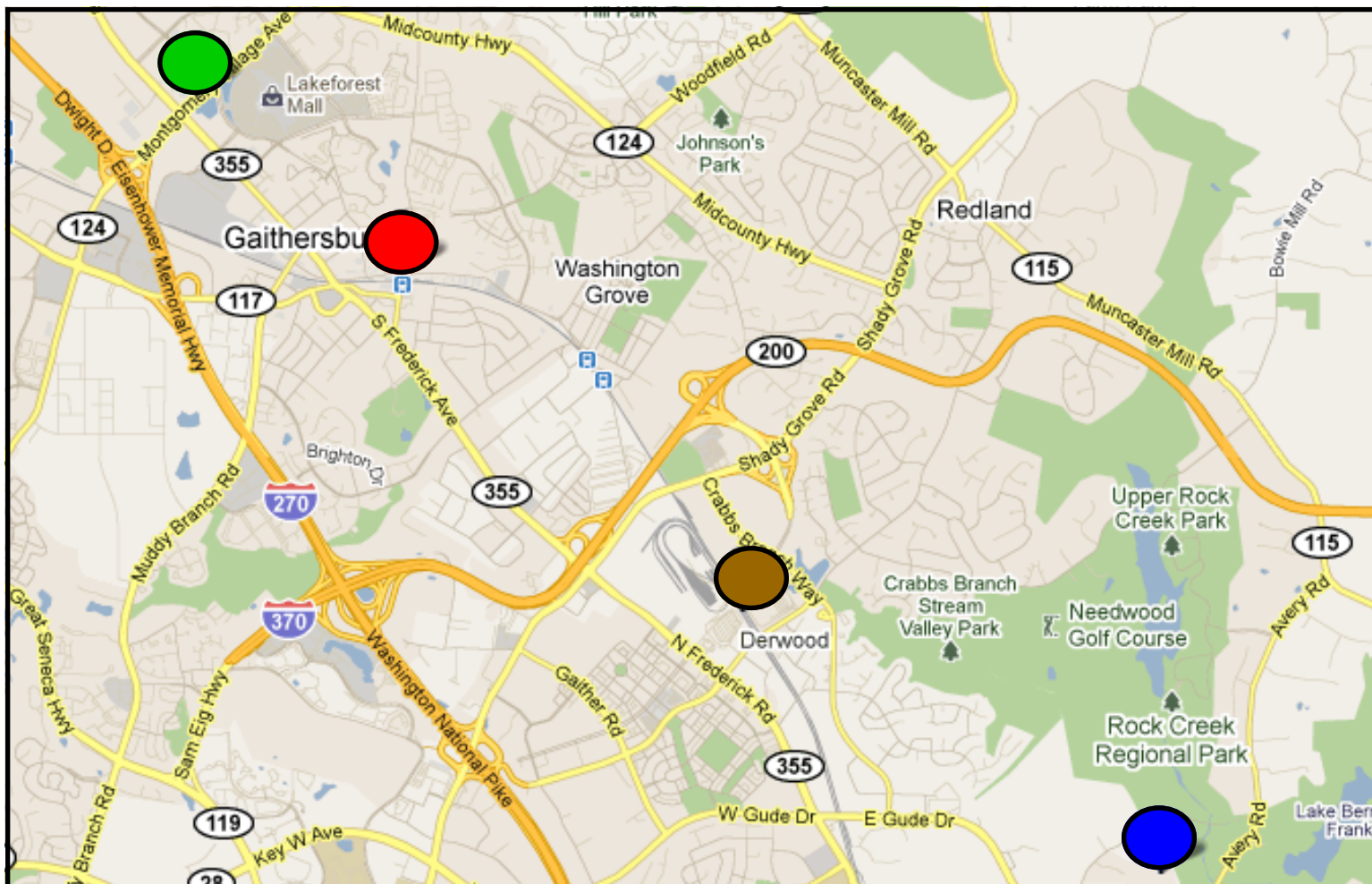
The Holiday Inn is closest to the Shady Grove Metro Station and can arrange for shuttle service to and from this location for guests.
